

THE TRANS-AUSTRALIAN RAILWAY GENERAL INFORMATION

AVAILABILITY OF TICKETS

Ordinary single inter-system tickets are available as follows:—

Single tickets between adjoining Systems, one month.

Single tickets between three or more Systems, three months.

Return tickets are available at the sum of two single fares.

Return tickets are available for six months.

Rail accommodation for **forward journeys** to and from Western Australia may be booked six calendar months in advance.

Return rail accommodation may be booked by passengers purchasing return tickets, up to seven calendar months in advance.

Break of journey is permitted at any station, provided the journey to destination is completed within the periods above-mentioned.

LUGGAGE.

Free Allowance.

Passengers undertaking journeys between Capital cities—

1st Class	168 lb.
2nd Class	112 lb.

Journeys other than above—

1st Class	112 lb.
2nd Class	84 lb.

Luggage Checks

Passengers may "check" their luggage between any of the places at which inter-system rail tickets are on issue.

As the space available for luggage in sleeping compartments is necessarily limited, passengers are recommended to take with them in the compartment one suitcase not exceeding 28 inches in length which can be placed in the rack provided for this purpose and one smaller case (say 14-16 inches).

Other luggage should be "checked through" in the brakevan.

"DRIVE YOURSELF" CAR SERVICE

Passengers from Adelaide and Melbourne to Perth may arrange to have a "Drive Yourself" motor car available on their arrival in Perth.

Explanation of Abbreviations and Symbols appearing in the Time Table.—**Stops only when required to set down passengers from Kalgoorlie or beyond... ††Stops only when required to pick up passengers for Kalgoorlie or beyond. **ET** denotes Eastern time, which is 2 hours ahead of Perth time and 30 minutes ahead of Adelaide time. **PT** denotes Perth time, which is 1½ hours behind Adelaide time and 2 hours behind Eastern time. **CT** denotes Central time, which is 45 minutes ahead of Perth time and 45 minutes behind Adelaide time. **AT** denotes Adelaide time, which is 1½ hours ahead of Perth time and 30 minutes behind Eastern time. **RR** denotes Refreshment Rooms at which meals may be obtained. **RR§** denotes Refreshment Rooms at which light refreshments only may be obtained. **(T)** Telegrams may be received at, or dispatched from stations so marked.
