#### FREIGHTING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Passengers who so desire may arrange to have their motor vehicles carried by rail between Port Pirie Junction and Parkeston (Commonwealth Railways terminal three miles east of Kalgoorlie). They are advised that the carriage of such vehicles is at THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER.

In special circumstances, car bookings may be accepted less than seven days in advance.

Passengers, before contacting the above officials, should arrange to complete their passenger bookings at any Railway Interstate Booking Office.

Passengers' motor vehicles are conveyed by the following trains:—

Westbound.—In the westbound direction passengers' motor vehicles are conveyed on goods trains which depart Port Pirie Junction shortly after the passenger train. They are available for delivery at Parkeston at 9.30 a.m. on the morning after the passenger arrives.

Transport will be provided between Kalgoorlie and Parkeston for the drivers only taking delivery of their motor vehicles at Parkeston.

Eastbound.—In the eastbound direction, passengers' motor vehicles are carried on goods trains which depart Parkeston on the afternoon of the day prior to departure of the passenger train. They are available for delivery at Port Pirie Junction shortly after arrival of the passenger train at that location.

Transport will be provided between Parkeston and Kalgoorlie for drivers only loading their motor vehicles at Parkeston.
